- 725 GRIFFON and 95 JAGUAR will have been produced by the end of the year. The first "MEPAC" 120mm mortar version of the GRIFFON will be delivered this year.

BOXER RCT30 and VBCI MkII: a complementary range of IFV

The BOXER RCT30 offers maximum mobility, a large crew compartment for accommodating infantry squads with combat equipment and high firepower including successfully and field proven combating small drones and swarms of drones at distances of up to 1,500 meters. The RCT30 is an unmatched unmanned turret, providing significant benefits to the entire crew (space, protection, operations,). Boxer RCT30 combines the proven and in-service Boxer vehicle and the Puma Turret. The RCT30 is therefore field proven, reliable and quickly available.

KNDS offers the VBCI MkII infantry fighting vehicle equipped with the T40 unmanned turret. This new turret integrates a 40CTA gun, AKERON MP missiles and a 7,62mm machinegun. As a modular system, the VBCI MkII is available in other versions such as command post, recovery vehicle, or 120mm mortar carrier.

Proven modularity on tracks: the BOXER tracked

The BOXER tracked was developed to meet current international requirements and addresses the need for a small logistics footprint through its modular concept, low costs and a simple digital operating concept.

The driving module has an increased level of protection and mobility that compared to other vehicles in its class. The drive module can be combined with all existing BOXER mission modules.

- 725 GRIFFON multi-purpose armored vehicle and 95 JAGUAR combat and reconnaissance vehicle made by KNDS, Arquus and Thales will have been produced by the end of the year.
- The first deliveries of the GRIFFON MEPAC, a version which integrates a 120mm 2R2M mortar are to occur in the second half of 2024.
- The new R2 standard of the JAGUAR combat and reconnaissance vehicle is being implemented in the production line.
- KNDS and its partner Texelis propose the new counter-UAV version of the SERVAL armed with the ARX30 remote-controlled weapon station.
